Players code of conduct
To be read prior to each game to both
teams, players, coaches & parents

- 1. Treat all opponents with respect
- 2. Play hard within the rules of the game
- 3. Keep control of your temper
- 4. Respect the referees and their decision without gestures or arguments
- 5. Win without boasting, lose without excuses
- 6. Never quit
- 7. No Slide tackling
- 8. Remember it is a privilege to represent your soccer club and community

Game checklist for referees

- Game preparation and equipment: Wear complete uniform, including whistle, coin, flags and cards
- Early arrival: 30 minutes prior to game
- · Field Inspection: glass, debris etc.
- Introduce yourself to coaches and players
- Player inspection: All players must:
 - •Wear shin guards covered with socks
 - •Wear approved shoes
 - Wear matching jerseys
 - •NO JEWELRY, no hair beads, no casts
 - •Only medical bracelets etc. allowed
- Late arrivals must be inspected
- Ask a player to read the code of conduct
- Check rosters, ensure ONLY coaches and players listed on the rosters can participate. You may accept a paper or smart phone version of the roster.
- Line Instructions: Each coach selects an Asst. Ref. prior to the game. ONLY IN and OUT of bounds can be called by these volunteers.
- Game ball selection and coin toss
- Game scores, cards and incident reports: You are required to keep accurate records of the game scores, cards, misbehavior by players, coaches, parents and field conditions. Report all problems.
- Game reports: You are responsible to send your reports by 5pm Monday following the game.
